Here are some examples to show you how to calculate points:

Let's say actual date of birth is: 7/7/2006

If you guessed: 7/7/2006 → You will get 15 points.

If you guessed: 7/5/2006 → You will get 15 – (2 days * 1 points) = 13 points. (1 point penalty per day for guessing early)

If you guessed: 7/9/2006 → You will get 15 – (2 days * 2 points) = 11 points. (2 point penalty per day for guessing late)

Rules:

1. Who will have most points will win a surprise gift prize from Mitul & Arpita. To break the tie bonus points will be taken off.
2. If Arpita wins then all Kids (16 and under) will get a surprise gift.
3. Point calculation is shown in question.
